Diocesan celebration for bishop leo o'reilly - There will be a concelebrated Mass in the Cathedral of SS. Patrick & Felim, Cavan, on the Feast of Pentecost, Sunday 9 June 2019, at 3:00p.m. to mark the Golden Jubilee of Bishop O'Reilly's Ordination to the Priesthood and also his recent retirement as Bishop of Kilmore. Bishop Leo will be the principal celebrant and the homily will be given by Monsignor Liam Kelly, the Diocesan Administrator. There will be an informal reception afterwards in St. Patrick's College.
