St Mogue's Day: Friday the 31st of January. St Mogue's Church, Bawnboy will be open from 8am until 10pm to accommodate those who would like to make the traditional Station. There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 5pm, concluding with Benediction at 7:45pm. Mass, in honour of St Mogue, will be celebrated at 8pm. The Station will be celebrated communally after Mass. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available from 7:15pm - 7:45pm and from 8:45pm-9:00pm.

Feast of St Mogue: Suggested Station: Pray before the Blessed Sacrament and say one Our Father, one Hail Mary, and one Glory Be as well as the Apostles' Creed for the Pope's intentions. **Make the Stations of the Cross.** (A suggested text will be available at the door). After you have completed the Stations, bring a bottle of holy water from one of the containers in the porch to St Mogue's Font. Pour the holy water into the font and kneel in front of it for a few moments while you recite prayers of your own choice. When you have finished praying at the font, pour the holy water back into the bottle using the jugs provided. That completes the Station.
