Corlough Church will be closed after Mass on Saturday evenings, Kilnavart Church will be closed after Mass until 1pm on Sundays and Bawnboy Church will be closed after Mass until 2pm on Sundays to allow time for the churches to be thoroughly sterilised.

Blessing of the Graves Fr Sean blessed the graves in Templeport last Sunday. He will privately bless the graves on St Mogue's Island on Monday and those in Corlough on the **9th of August**. These ceremonies will be recorded and posted on the Parish Facebook page.

There will be a **Mass for the Deceased** of the Parish on Monday, the 3rd August at 12 noon in Kilnavart. Those who are buried in our parish cemeteries and those who passed away since the Blessing of the Graves last year will be especially commemorated.
