Parish Mass for St Mogue's College In light of the challenges posed for our post-primary schools in the diocese by Covid-19, a series of parish Masses will be held over the coming weeks. During the celebration of these Masses, we will pray that all staff, students, parents/guardians within our schools remain healthy and virus free. We will also seek Our Lord's guidance and grace to restore calm and assurance amid the uncertainty and concern created by the pandemic. You are welcome to attend Mass on Tuesday at 10am in St Mogue's Church, Bawnboy to pray for all associated with St Mogue's College as they embark on a new academic year.

Face coverings: Following recent consultations with public health authorities, the Christian church leaders formally recommends and encourages the use of face coverings at all services of worship, along with the ongoing maintenance of 2 metre physical distancing from this weekend.

The Episcopal Ordination of the Very Reverend Martin Hayes as Bishop of Kilmore will take place on Sunday 20 September 2020 in the Cathedral of SS. Patrick & Felim, Cavan at 3:00pm. Unfortunately, due to COVID-19 restrictions, the numbers attending the ceremony will be greatly reduced and will be by invitation only with only his immediate family and a few friends attending. The ceremony itself will be live-streamed on the internet and may be viewed at www.churchservices.tv/cavancathedral. Further information regarding the ordination will be published over the coming weeks. In the meantime, we continue to pray for Fr. Hayes as he prepares to take up his new ministry as shepherd of God's flock in the Diocese of Kilmore.
